Finnova presents the 5G-DiGITs Project in Brussels to young beneficiaries of the GENIUS Program from the Provincial Council of Tarragona



 Digitalization training aims to equip Europe with the necessary skills to face the technological era, promoting the development of technological and sustainable competencies.

Brussels, February 26, 2025. Yesterday, **Tuesday, February 25,** Finnova hosted at its headquarters in Brussels the **Welcome Day** of the **Genius Program** from the **Provincial Council of Tarragona**, an international mobility program through which **ten young people from Tarragona** benefit from a professional stay in Brussels to later transfer the acquired knowledge to a municipal entity in the region. During the session, **Alberto Navarro, Finnova's Human Resources Director,** presented **5G-DiGITs,** an ambitious **Erasmus+-funded project** aimed at preparing Europe for the **5G era** by developing **digital and sustainable skills.**

The **5G-DiGITs project**, which spans **36 months** from its launch on **November 1, 2024**, has a total budget of **€1,745,421** and brings together a consortium of **European partners** committed to **digital transformation** and the training of professionals in **emerging technologies**.

Among its main objectives are the **development of essential digital and green skills** for the integration of **5G across various sectors**; the **promotion of collaboration between academic institutions, businesses, and public administrations** to create synergies in

professional training; and the **advancement of sustainable innovation** through digitalization and the **efficient use of new technologies.**

GENIUS: An Opportunity for Young Talent

Since 2020, young people under 35 years old, residing in the Tarragona region, holding a university degree, and registered as job seekers, have been eligible for the Genius program, a scholarship initiative offered by the Provincial Council of Tarragona. This program enables participants to benefit from a professional stay in Brussels, where they gain valuable experience before transferring their acquired knowledge to a municipal entity in the region.

GENIUS is an **international mobility program** that provides young people with opportunities through **training stays in Brussels**, aiming to prepare participants in **strategic and relevant sectors for the region**. The driving force behind this initiative, supported by the **Finnova Foundation** for program **management and monitoring**, is to **professionalize candidates** in **European policies and legislation**, focusing on areas such as **tourism**, **energy efficiency**, **sustainability**, **the primary sector**, and the **circular economy**.

The program offers financial aid of €9,300 per participant. The professional stay lasts a total of seven months, five of which take place in Brussels, where participants acquire knowledge and practical experience, followed by two months in a local entity, transferring improvement proposals and developing European projects at the local level.

The program participants were selected through a rigorous process and are highly qualified university graduates. During their stay, they receive a monthly financial allowance, medical coverage, and funding for travel expenses. In addition to their internships at host entities, participants take part in a specialized training program provided by Finnova, covering key aspects such as European funding calls, institutional communication in the EU, and the legal framework of the European Union.

During this **Welcome Day**, beneficiaries participated in a **specialized training session on European projects**, delivered by **Finnova experts**. The session covered **European funding opportunities** and presented various **projects** in which the **foundation** is involved, equipping attendees with **key tools** to navigate the field of **European funding acquisition**.

Since its inception on **January 7, 2025,** this program has provided young people with the opportunity to **integrate into the European ecosystem, develop their professional**

skills, and expand their network of contacts in the fields of innovation and digitalization.

By presenting the **5G-DiGITs** project, Finnova reinforces training in **5G** as a key tool for employability and professional growth. This project highlights the importance of **5G** in the evolution of sectors such as industry, education, and mobility. Finnova reaffirms its commitment to training, technological innovation, and transnational collaboration to foster talent and build a more digital and sustainable Europe.
