

5G-DiGITs builds a European alliance to train the workforce of the digital and green transitions

The EU-funded project brings together universities, VET centres and industry to bridge the skills gap in advanced 5G technologies



Brussels, 18 August 2025. The digital revolution in Europe requires a skilled, future-ready workforce. As the deployment of 5G technologies accelerates, the **5G-DiGITs** project is tackling a pressing challenge: how to train professionals capable of using advanced technologies in a responsible, sustainable and innovative way.

Funded by the **Erasmus+ programme**, 5G-DiGITs brings together a **consortium of 12 organisations** from **Germany, Greece, Spain, Lithuania, Malta, Ireland, Belgium and Sweden**. The alliance includes **higher education institutions, vocational education and training (VET) providers, technology companies and business support organisations**. This diverse partnership aims to develop forward-looking curricula, promote entrepreneurship and connect education with the needs of the labour market.

The project focuses on designing new learning pathways that combine **digital skills, green competencies** and an **entrepreneurial mindset**. It also supports **green entrepreneurship programmes**, encourages cross-border cooperation, and promotes knowledge exchange through accelerator schemes, staff exchanges and networking events.

“The rapid evolution of 5G technologies has created a skills gap across Europe. 5G-DiGITS is a response to that gap. We are working to ensure that the benefits of these technologies reach society through inclusive, sustainable and innovation-driven training programmes,” said a spokesperson for the project.

In line with the **EU's digital and green transitions**, the project integrates sustainability and social responsibility into all its educational content. It aims to prepare professionals not only to work with 5G, but to understand its impact and harness its potential for solving real-world challenges.

5G-DiGITS goes beyond technical training. It is about purpose. It empowers people to turn 5G into a driver of fair and sustainable transformation across Europe.
